FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

GOSPEL OF JOHN 6:1-15

“GOD MULTIPLIES WHAT WE SURRENDER TO HIM”

“Hopefully, the story of Elisha’s miraculous multiplication of bread reminded you of the gospel stories in which Jesus multiplies loaves and fishes to feed the crowds. The Gospel of John shares only a few stories with the other three Gospels, but this story is in all four (Matthew 14:13-21, Mark 9:32-44; Luke 9:10-17). One detail that makes John’s version distinctive from the others is the mention of barley loaves, which ties it to today’s first reading.

Today’s Gospel opens with a reference to location (the shore of the Sea of Galilee), the motivation of the crowd (they were looking for signs, or miracles). Passover is a commemoration of the Israelites’ rescue from slavery, and it is celebrated with unleavened bread and other reminders of their time in Egypt and of promises for the future. While the mountain is unnamed, this detail may have been included to make the reader think of Sinai, where God made covenant with Moses and the Israelites.

John’s version of the story features Philip and Andrew, two of the disciples who were among the first to be called to follow Jesus (see John 1:35-51). Also unique to John’s version of the story is the mention that Jesus himself distributes the loaves. In the synoptic Gospels, the disciples are given the task of distributing the food. Before distributing the loaves, the narrator says that Jesus gave thanks. The Greek word is *eucharisteó*. It reminds us of the Jewish prayer before meals, but it also points to the Bread of Life discourse that will follow (John 6:32-59).

All four Gospels mention the twelve baskets of leftovers, but John describes Jesus’ command to the disciples with these words: “**Gather the fragments left over, so that nothing will be wasted.**” This vocabulary is also found in the *Didache*, a second-century church order that includes the following Eucharistic prayer: “*We thank you, our Father, for the life and knowledge which You made known to us, through Jesus Your Servant; to you be the glory forever. Even as this broken bread [fragment] was scattered over the hills, and was gathered together and became one, so let Your Church be gathered together from the ends of the earth into Your kingdom.*” *Didache* 9:3-4; <http://www.newadvent.org/father's/0714.htm>).

National NFP Awareness Week
Celebrate and reverence
God's vision of human sexuality

The dates of Natural Family Planning Awareness Week, provided annually by the Natural Family Planning Program of the USCCB, highlights the anniversary of the papal encyclical *Humanae Vitae* (July 25) which articulates Catholic beliefs about human sexuality, conjugal love, and responsible parenthood. The dates also mark the feast of Saints Joachim and Anne (July 26), the parents of the Blessed Mother. Pope Francis has designated that feast as World Grandparents Day, a fitting commemoration during National NFP Awareness Week!

The Church teaches that the sacrament of marriage symbolizes Christ's relationship with His Church. What is this relationship but one of total, faithful, permanent, and fruitful love!

When couples live their vocation according to Church teachings, especially with regard to the transmission of life, many benefits can be reaped. Indeed, married couples who use Natural Family Planning (NFP) report that among these benefits is their mutual growth in holiness and consequent deepening of their respect and awe of God's gifts of human sexuality, marriage, and family. These are gifts that call for praise!

Prayer and Liturgy is at the heart of the Catholic faith-filled life. It is important to plan prayer events that reflect on God's plan for married love. In addition, clergy should encourage married couples to pray about God's will for their families. Is it time to welcome another child in the family? Prayerful discernment is a real aide for husband and wife.

July 25: Pope Francis Celebrates World Day for Grandparents & Elderly



Vatican City – “To express the closeness of God and of the church to every older person, Pope Francis has chosen “I am with you always” from the Gospel of Matthew as the theme for the first World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly.

The theme for the celebration July 25 is especially appropriate “in these challenging pandemic times,” said the announcement from the Dicastery for Laity, the Family and Life.

“‘I am with you always’ is also a promise of closeness and hope that young and old can mutually share. Not only are grandchildren and young people called upon to be present in the lives of older people, but older people and grandparents also have a mission of evangelization, proclamation, and prayer, and of encouraging young people in their faith,” the statement said.

Pope Francis announced in late January that he was establishing the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, which is to be celebrated each year on the fourth Sunday of July to coincide with the feast of Sts. Joachim and Anne, Jesus’ grandparents.

“In the encyclical, ‘Fratelli Tutti,’ the Holy Father reminds us that no one is saved alone. With this in mind, we must treasure the spiritual and human wealth that has been handed down from generation to generation,” he said.
